## ***S*** CHINA

### **1. \*\*\*PU ERH.....€5.90**

*Pu-erh is China's great mystery tea famous for its health giving benefits, very low caffeine levels and rich, unique and comforting flavour. The secret is the addition of an ancient bacterial culture, by adding old, ground Puerh during the fermentation process and ageing in conditions that are not too hot and humid. The Chinese believe that Pu-erh has even greater health properties than other teas.*

### **Black Teas**

### **2. \*\*\*KEEMUN.....€5.90**

*Of all the black teas that China produces, Keemun is perhaps the most well-known. Keemun has gained a reputation for an indescribable flavor, with hints of smoky pine, orchid, crushed apple and a rich sweet taste. The aroma of Keemun is fruity, with hints of pine and floweriness which creates the very distinctive and balanced taste. It also displays a hint of delicious orchid fragrance and the so-called 'China tea sweetness'.*

### **Red teas**

### **3. \*\*\* ZHENG SHAN XIAO ZHONG (Lapsang).....€7.90**

*The Lapsang Souchong, known as Zheng Shan Xiao Zhong tea in China, is a special red tea from the Wuyi mountain fabled by legends. After the leaves have been oxidized, the drying of the leaves is speed up by firing using local pine wood. Anyway, the exact formula of tea preparation is Chinese's very well kept secret. That process is what gives this tea a distinctively rich and malty flavor. This fine Chinese red tea has a very thick, strong liquor, which can be served plain or with milk and sugar.*

### **Green teas**

### **4. \*\*\*CHINA SENCHA..... €6.90**

*This is a fresh, fragrant Sencha style green tea made in China using Japanese techniques. Slender, dark green leaves produce a delicate green cup which is slightly sweet and earthy in taste.*

**5.\*\*\*LUNG CHING TEA – Dragon Well /multiple infusions...€10.90**

Also known as Dragon Well tea is produced by hand through a 10 part process. The tea used to produce Dragon Well is grown by the side of West Lake in Zhejiang Province. Dragon Well is distinguished by its beautiful shape, emerald colour, scented smell and tending sweet floral character. In Chinese culture Dragon Well is looked upon as an excellent gift to give to your friends as once it was a gift to emperors. Drinking this unique tea is like touching of the heaven...

**6.\*\*\* GUNPOWDER TEMPLE OF HEAVEN..... €5.90**

Green tea from the Guangdong province of China. The name of this tea is said to derive from its visual similarity to military gunpowder,. Gunpowder is the favorite green tea of Morocco and the Middle East, where it is commonly prepared with mint and sugar. See our Touareg tea.

**7.\*\*\*CHUN MEE – Precious Eyebrow..... €5.90**

Chun Mee Eyebrow Tea is the most popular of the Chinese green tea. Its well-formed, tender, curved leaves yield a full-flavored, sweet tasting infusion. Try this tea for those times when you need a refreshing moment during your day.

**Semi -green teas**

**8.\*\*\*TIE GUANYIN OOLONG TEA- Iron Goddess of Mercy /multiple infusions.....€10.90**

Tie Guanyin is a premium variety of [Chinese oolong tea](#) associated with [Anxi](#) in [Fujian province](#). This oolong is typically close to a green tea, with only a little fermentation. Subsequently, it has a very flowery, delicate aroma without the green tea "grassiness" or astringency.

There is few legends behind this tea. One of them says, the tea was gift from Goddess of Mercy to poor farmer for his care of her temple.

**9.\*\*\*SHOU MEI “Eyebrow”/multiple infusions.....€9.90**

From Fujian province, Shou Mei yields a delicate infusion with mellow flavor. This is a new lot, with a slightly bolder leaf style. Shou Mei White Tea is produced from naturally withered upper leaf and tips, with a stronger flavor reminiscent of lighter Oolong teas. Shou Mei or "Eyebrow" tea is named for the long, thin, crescent-shaped leaves used in production. This tea is a rare Shou Mei White Tea and hard to find. Light aroma, sweet and strong tea taste. If steeped for too long, the tea has a bitter taste. Spoil yourself and try this special tea today.

**10. \*\*\*BAI MU DAN /multiple infusions.....€9.90**

*Bai Mu Dan is a White tea. It is produced in the spring and is usually covered in white down. The tea is usually grown in the Fujian Province of China from Da Bai or Large White tea trees. White tea in general is the least processed tea of all, remaining most of its innate properties. The Bai Mudan that we offer here is of the highest grade, thus it is called "King" or "Wang" in Chinese. Bai Mudan is known for its high proportion of anti-oxidants polyphenols and for its cooling effects.*

## **S MAROCCO**

**11. \*\*\*TUAREG ..... €6.90**

*Contains sugar*

*Tuareg tea is huge in North Africa where it has assumed a social significance. The north African tea ceremony is well known to be the oil in the cogs of commerce from Morocco to Egypt; it spread along with the Sahara's nomadic tribes from the Berbers in the northwest to the Tuareg in the Sahara, and if you ever try to buy a carpet in a carpet shop or a pair of slippers in a souq, you'll be offered tea. It's an unavoidable part of life in desert Africa.*

*The Tuareg are particularly into their tea ceremonies, and as you wander through countries where the Tuareg proliferate, such as Mauritania, Niger and Mali, you see people brewing tea everywhere .It comes with sugar.*

## **S SOUTH AMERICA**

**12. \*\*\*MATÉ RANCHO..... €5.90**

*Mate Green gives a greenish taste. Mate is rich in vitamins and minerals, it is considered a nourishing all-body tonic. It also can be used as a stimulant to treat mental and physical fatigue and headaches. Maté green is an energizing drink. Due to its natural caffeine, it stimulates digestion, metabolism, and circulation. Mate is served with a metal straw from a shared hollow calabash gourd. The straw is called a bombilla in Latin American Spanish. Modern commercially available straws are typically made of nickel silver (called Alpaca), stainless steel, or hollow-stemmed cane.*

**13. \*\*\*MATÉ LEMON..... €6.50**

*Mate Rancho mixed with lemon grass...cool refreshing taste.*

**14. \*\*\*MATE DE PARAGUAY..... €6.90**

*Contains honey*

*The national beverage in Paraguay is a tea called mate. Ceshire de Paraguay is flavoured by smoked tea Lapsang Souchong and bit of honey. It is served in wooden cups, and is drunk through a metal straw called a bombilla.*

## **S INDIA**

**15. \*\*\* DARJEELING PUSSIMBING /2 infusions..... €9.90**

*The best among the finest traditional 1st Flush teas that Darjeeling could conceive this year, this tea is plucked from the pure china origin young bushes and has been sorted very well as a result of which almost all the leafs are of similar size in the tea, the blossom of the tea is very greenish and bright mainly due to the high altitude growth and early harvest factors, when infused the cup gives an extravagant high fruity aroma and an aftertaste that reminds of caramellic, honey and lemony like taste.*

**16. \*\*\* DARJEELING SINGBULLI /2 infusions.....€9.90**

*Darjeeling has four picking seasons and 86 individual gardens or estates, Singbulli being one of the top ones. These whole leaf grades make up less than 6% of tea picked and require extra care in handling. This tea has lots of beautiful leaf tips or buds and lovely vegetable and floral scents. Cup liquor is amber. In the cup this tea is notably astringent, puckery, floral and layered.*

*In Darjeeling the first and second pickings, or flushes, are of particular distinction. Second Flush tea, picked in May/June, offers rounded, fuller flavor that retains fragrance and is a characteristic of fine Darjeelings. The Singbulli tea garden is in the Mirik Valley of Darjeeling at an altitude of 3600 feet.*

**17. \*\*\* DARJEELING JUNGAPANA /2 infusions..... €9.90**

*Darjeeling Jungpana FTGFOP1 Second Flush, this tea, from the renowned Jungpana Estate, has an excellent leaf appearance with many silvery buds. The infusion is bright auburn in color, has a nutty-sweet aroma and a wonderful muscatel flavor, rounded off with fruity notes.*

**18. \*\*\* DARJEELING CASTLETON SF /2 infusions..... €9.90**

*An excellent 2nd flush Darjeeling from the prestigious Castleton tea estate with a classic muscatel character, FTGFOP1. The Castleton estate is near the town of Kurseong in the Darjeeling district of northern India. Castleton is one of the top estates in Darjeeling and consistently produces top teas - and not surprisingly obtains the top prices.*

## **NEW Darjeeling Teas -First Flush**

### **19.\*\*\* Darjeeling Tukvar/2 infusions.....€9.90**

*A very nice offering from one of the oldest tea growers in Darjeeling, this tea has bold leaves that are rolled very finely with fair amount of full size silver buds, when steeped the cup gives out some very refreshing floral aroma with a very bright liquor and the after taste that ends with a balanced briskness. A delicious tea of the season!*

### **20.\*\*\*Puttabong Queen/2 infusions.....€12.90**

*An extra-ordinary superfine offering from one of the best 1st Flush Darjeeling tea growers, this tea is carefully plucked from the organic section of the garden, which consists of extremely young unbroken shoots and buds plucked by 10-15 expert tea pluckers at the early hours of the morning when the dew drops were present on these young leaves and buds. A top of the line offering which cannot be further replicated!*

### **21.\*\*\*Gopaldhara.....€9.90**

*The name Gopaldhara is a derivative of two words. 'Gopal' the beloved god-child of Hindu mythology and 'dhara', stream of fresh and pure spring water. The name embodies the philosophy followed by the Company - "To provide pure exclusive tea, fit to be appreciated even by the Gods." The estate is located in pictureque surroundings near the town of Mirik, in the district of Darjeeling. Grown at an elevation of 7400 feet, the highest tea growing elevation in the world. The pure aroma and light golden liquor is a delight to be savoured.*

*This tea from Gopaldhara is manufactured from tea bushes especially selected and planted to give a unique unforgettable flavour. Each invoice is matchless, memorable and a tea drinker's joy.*

*The classy apperance itself stimulates the senses and one instantly falls in love, never to forget the beautiful experience of savouring the brew.*

## **Black teas**

### **22.\*\*\*ASSAM CTC ..... €5.90**

*Classic Assam - no surprises, just good, rich, and smooth tea. Assam is located in northeast India and through this India State flows the mighty Brahmaputra River. Assam is the home of the tiger and the one-horned rhino. It is jungle and it is magnificent mountain. It is the world's single largest tea-growing region, producing more than 1,500,000 pounds of tea annually. There are some stunning, absolutely stunning, high quality (and very expensive) teas produced in this tea wonderland.*

## **S** NEPAL

### **23. \*\*\*MEGHMA OOLONG (hand made)/2 infusions..... €9.90**

*This is a very unique, fresh 2008 latest autumn flush oolong from Nepal. It is a semi-fermented tea, producing pale liquor with a deliciously refreshing honey flavor. It is cultivated in the highlands of the Himalayas at an elevation above 7000 ft, in a pristine natural environment free from roads, pollution and pesticides. This tea is manufactured by hand as an artisan tea.*

### **24. \*\*\*KUWAPANI SF /2 infusions..... €9.90**

*Kuwapani is a premium high grown himalayan orthodox black tea full of delectable muscatel flavor with rich aroma, bright infusion and stylish appearance.*

### **25. \*\*\*Golden Himalayan Tips - Oolong tea/2 infusions .....€9.90**

*Jun Chiyabari is a small and exclusive tea garden in the eastern Himalayan region of Nepal, around the hills of Hile in Dhankuta district. This beautiful hand-made tea is subtle, yet extremely complex. Consisting of one young leaf and a bud, it yields a golden cup color with natural sweetness and fruity notes. Smooth and elegant - a treat for the nose and palate.*

### **26. \*\*\*Silver Tips - high grown white tea/multiple infusions.....€9.90**

*This garden is situated at the 6000 ft. elevation above sea level on Nepal's eastern Indian border. Tea from this garden has a high tip content that produces a very light liquor. Highly recommended.*

## **S** JAPAN

### **27. \*\*\*YANAGI..... € 5.90**

*Yanagi is composed of pruned tea leaves that have been processed in the same way as Sencha, but is not as flavorful as Sencha. It is light and mild in flavor, so that it is suitable for everyday use.*

*In the course of making Sencha, it happens that some leaves fall out in the rubbing process and come out flat, folded in two or double-folded in four. Because they look like willow leaves, the tea made of such leaves is called Willow, which has a lighter and less lingering taste than Sencha. Not a few people prefer to*

drink it after a meal as well as between meals.  
Tea leaves are naturally bigger than Sencha's.

**28. \*\*\*TAMARYOKUCHA/ multiple infusions.....€10.90**

Tamaryokucha is a fine Japanese green tea that has a tangy, berry-like taste, with a long almondy aftertaste and a deep aroma with tones of citrus, grass, and berries. It is produced in the [Kyūshū](#) area. The tea is golden yellow and it should be steeped at 70°C for about 2 minutes. The [caffeine](#) level is normal for green tea and it can be drunk throughout the day. It can be reinfused, with a slightly different taste.

**29. \*\*\*GENMAI CHA.....€5.90**

Genmai Cha is an exotic Japanese recipe that combines popped rice and popcorn with tender and delicate green tea leaves.

Unlike the affordable luxury it had become today, tea was historically a pricy commodity. The Japanese peasants found it difficult to afford much tea, and would mix it with roasted rice, which was abundant and cheap. Thus, they were able to squeeze more cups from the same amount of leaves. A recipe born of poverty, Genmai Cha had now acquired an uptown chic.

**30. \*\*\*GYOKURO FUUKI "Pearl Dew"/ multiple infusions....€14.00**

The Japanese have treasured [Gyokuro](#) for hundreds of years as the finest green tea. Now the best grades of this tea are becoming more widely available outside of Japan.

This green tea from Japan famed for its unique shading process. Gyokuro, meaning 'pearl dew,' is among the finest of Japanese teas.

Three weeks prior to plucking, tea bushes are shaded from the sun. The fruits of this hard work are evident in each cup. As a result, the tea plant produces more chlorophyll, which changes the proportions of the sugars, amino acids, caffeine and flavanols that contribute to the color, aroma and taste. Less exposure to sunlight results in a mild and sweet flavor and less astringency.

Special, labor-intensive processing skills are required to produce Gyokuro. Careful control over the processing is necessary because the shade-grown leaf buds are softer and hold more moisture and flavor than many other kinds of green tea.

**31. \*\*\*MATCHA.....€7.90**

Matcha is powdered green tea from Japan. Premium matcha is made in limited amounts in Japan. It is the heart of the "way of tea" and its preparation is celebrated in the Japanese Tea Ceremony.

When you drink matcha you consume the leaves, unlike other green teas. For this reason matcha contains, by volume, higher concentrations of catechins and vitamins.

**32.\*\*\* YABUKITA - Competition grade/multiple infusions..... €14.50**

*Harvested in early May, the tea is flash steamed then carefully rolled & dried to capture the natural vitamins and antioxidant polyphenols held within the youngest leaves. The leaf of this sencha is small and lightly twisted and holds sweet floral-green fragrance. Infusions of Pine Breeze possess a flowery-green bouquet, which is delicately flavoured with a pleasantly bitter finish. This is the highest grade of Yabukita.*

**33.\*\*\*SENCHA TSUYUHIKARI /multiple infusions.....€9.90**

*A very good Sencha from Sencha Tsuyuhikari that was especially cultivated for highlands in prefectship Shizuoka, cross-bred culture Shizu 7132 and Asatsuyu. This tea has a beautiful, bright-green infusion with a very fresh, sweetness flavor with fruity reverberation. The garden is located near to village Nunosawa – 2000 meters above the sea.*

**34.\*\*\*SENCHA HOUKOUEN/multiple infusions ..... €9.90**

*A very good Sencha from chosen mix of breeds gives you a beautiful goldenly yellow colour. The taste is stronger but still smooth with a dominant taste of immature fruit and fresh cut grass with slightly bitterness in reverberation. The garden is located near to village Nunosawa.*

**35.\*\*\*ChÉ XANH) /multiple infusions..... €9.90**

*High quality Vietnamese green tea produced with special care. The green tea from great tea district. The tea of the year 1993.*

**36.\*\*\* ROOIBOS..... €5.90**

Modeled on the former Georgian tea which despite any Wodka legends, has been most commonly drunk in the former USSR. This Russia Tea comes from China via old trade routes.

Turkish beverage prepared from orchid tubers; milky white in appearance, with only a slight flavour. Salep is also a seasonal drink. It is drunk warm during the cold winter days. Salep is made from the dried powder roots of wild orchids. It tastes very sweet and comes with milk. It is also used as cure for sour throats and coughs.

39. \*\*\*RIZE TEA..... €5.90

Rize tea or Çay is a form of black tea. Produced in Rize Province on the eastern Black Sea coast of Turkey which has a mild climate with high precipitation and fertile Soil, it is crystal clear and mahogany in color. It is drunk everywhere in Turkey, anytime. .It comes with sugar.

## **S** YOGI TEAS

40. \*\*\*MASALA..... €8.90
